



BC AQUASONICS AIR QUALITY POLICY

BC Aquasonics has an Air Quality Policy in place that is centred around our number one concern for the health and well being of our athletes, coaches and volunteers.

The policy will be to modify or cancel training sessions when the BC AQHI (British Columbia Air Quality Health Index) shows that the local air quality is a cause for concern.

AQHI less than 4 will mean practices will go ahead as normal.

AQHI 4-6 will mean that practices may be modified to allow for poor air quality conditions.

AQHI 7 and higher will mean that practices will be cancelled.

Measurements at the North Delta station will guide our decision for Bear Creek Pool practices and measurements at the Port Moody station will guide our decision for Centennial pool practices. We will aim to give families 24-hour notice of any cancellations, but this might not always be possible. Please always check your email prior to travelling to practice. SPECIAL NOTE

Due to the difficulty in securing pool time this season (2020-2021), we will be unable to reschedule missed practices. Should BCAQ receive a refund for the cancelled pool time, families will receive a pro rata credit that will be applied in the following month's invoice.
